Thanks to the resilience of the Moab community and the generous help from volunteers, the Moab Music Festival is thrilled to be able to move ahead with its 30th anniversary season in the face of the devastating flooding that inundated Moab earlier this week. With most Festival concerts being outdoors, there has been much to contend with, but the season launched in style yesterday, with a raft trip and enthusiastic patrons and performers. Concerts bring listeners to various outdoor venues along the Colorado River, sunset float concerts, local ranches, music hikes to "secret locations," rafting adventures, intimate (outdoor) gatherings, several free in-town popups, an event with three world premieres by female Native American composers, along with Bela Fleck, The JACK Quartet and Time for Three and much more. Join us and witness how the Festival and its world class artists still make music against the majestic sky and blazing red rock cliffs.
